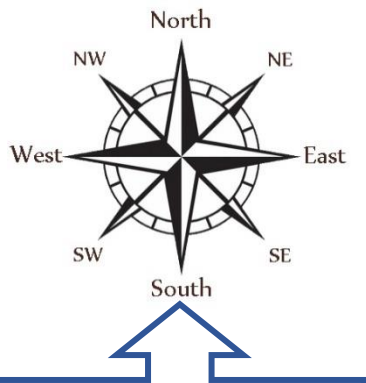


Year 2 Autumn 1: Journeys - Geography Knowledge Organiser



- A **country** is a land lived in by people with a common government, a **continent** is a major area of land; an **ocean** is a huge body of salt water.
- A **landmark** is a feature of a place that makes it easily recognisable.
- **Physical features** are natural objects; **human features** are things that are built by humans.
- A **capital** is a city or town where the central government is located.
