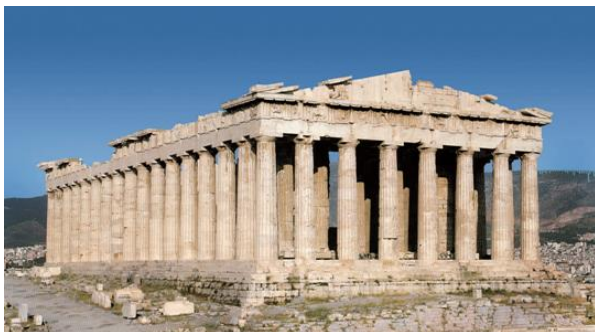
- BC means 'Before Christ'
