Our aim with the drop-ins is to give you a valuable insight into the learning expectations for your child, to provide a window into the classroom experience, to support the positive relationship between home and school and for your child(ren) to see that their education is valued by both home and school. Although the drop-ins were extremely well attended, we are of course aware that not all parents could attend at the allotted time. Therefore, when we run the drop-ins in the Spring Term, we will make sure that each class has theirs on a different day – and possibly a different time.

Thank you also to those parents who have booked their child's Parent/Teacher meeting already. These meetings are a really important way of supporting the partnership between home and school that is needed ensure that your child has the best possible education. At the time of writing we have less than 50% of the appointments booked. If you have not yet booked yours, please do so as soon as possible (unless you have made alternative arrangements with your child's class Teacher. If you are attending a face-to-face session, your child's books will be available for you to look at either before or after the appointment. 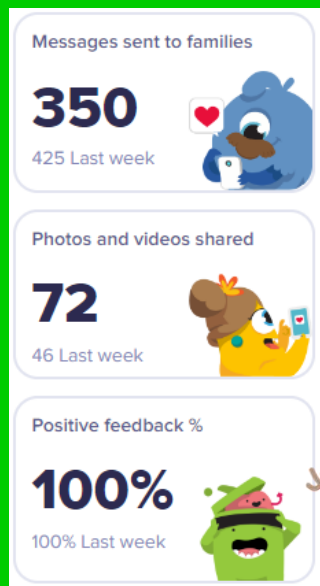

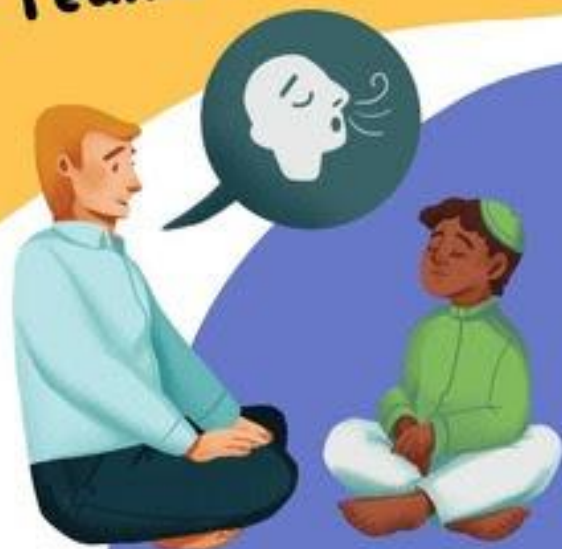
